An Exciting Adventure

Descend into a South American rainforest filled with exotic plants, several species of monkeys and beautiful toucans. Follow the bamboo-planked paths into the jungle where you find Orinoco crocodiles, Giant river otters and Anacondas. The journey continues underwater for a look at the River exhibit filled with turtles, catfish and the only Antillean manatee in the United States.

You are then surrounded by more than 85,000 gallons of saltwater exhibits where Moon jellyfish, stingrays clownfish and rare Leafy seadragons are only a few of the intriguing marine life. See the colony of South African Black-footed penguins in their outdoor exhibit. Mundo Maya is an immersion exhibit that highlights the flora and fauna important to the Maya culture. Animals such as venomous

The 40-foot tunnel gives an underwater view of the Sacred Cenote that is filled with sharks. The tall Ceiba tree represents the Maya "Tree of Life." The archaeological and anthropological contributions of the Maya, add a new dimension to The Dallas World Aquarium.
