# THE DALLAS WORLD AQUARIUM

Welcome to eighteen~O~one. We hope this tranquil setting will make for an enjoyable meal. Our menu features native dishes from the reefs' neighboring countries, including Australia, Fiji, Indonesia and Mexico. As changeable as the tides, the menu varies with the exhibits. Restaurant hours are 11:30 A.M. to 2:30 P.M., with exception to Spring Break and Holidays.

The Dallas World Aquarium opened to the public in October 1992. Built in 1924, the empty warehouse had been occupied until 1982. During those years it was used for various industries, including the Mohawk Rubber Company and Pioneer Steel Rule and Die. The adjacent building at 1815 North Griffin Street was purchased in 1996. Built in 1929 as a warehouse for the storage of rubber goods, it was later used by a Venetian blind company in the early 1950's and lastly, prior to the aguarium's expansion, as a restaurant/bar known as "Tejano Rodeo". As in the first building, the interior was completely demolished, leaving only the brick walls and support structure. The alley between the two buildings became the "channel" between the freshwater and saltwater ecosystems. The ORINOCO - Secrets of the River opened to the public in October 1997. The parking lot at 1814 Laws Street (behind 1801 North Griffin) was purchased in May 2000 for the first newly constructed portion of the facility. Construction on Mundo Maya exhibit started in April 2002 and opened to the public in August 2004. The "Yellow Building" (across Corbin Street at 1901 North Griffin) was purchased in May 2001. Built in 1946, the warehouse was used for wholesale electrical supplies until 1970 and had remained vacant from 1988 until time of sale. The renovation of this facility provided staff offices, breeding centers, animal clinic, animal commissary and off exhibit aviaries and nursery. A portion of the second and third floors were utilized as the Dallas World Aquarium corporate offices until 2018, when the offices were renovated as a new venue space. The Endangered Species Gallery.

The Dallas World Aquarium offers a unique alternative for a variety of catered functions for groups of 25 to 2000. The first floor aquarium, the Reef Room, can host 110 for a formal seated dinner and 200 for cocktail social. The first floor of the Orinoco - Secrets of the River exhibit consists of the Orinoco Room (underwater viewing of the Manatee), can host 60 guests for a formal seated dinner, and the Tribal Gallery, featuring approximately 2500 square feet of open venue space is available for wedding ceremonies and receptions of up to 200 guests. Cafe Maya, third floor of the Mundo Maya exhibit provides seated service for 125 or cocktail service for 200. In addition to the beautiful indoor view overlooking Mundo Maya, an adjoining outdoor patio is available for warm weather enjoyment. The Endangered Species Gallery features the complete collection of Pop Icon, Andy Warhol's, Endangered Species Collection and can host events for up to 300 for seated and 500 guests for cocktail social. The third floor features a veranda offering sweeping views of the Dallas skyline.

The Gift Shop (2nd floor Mundo Maya) and Bookstore (1st floor aquarium) offer a variety of educational books, games, videos and toys.

While waiting, younger children are encouraged to ask for our free Color Sheet. Please ask a Gift Shop or Admission attendant to explain how a portion of your entrance fee may be applied toward an aquarium annual membership, thus eliminating future admission fees when visiting The Dallas World Aquarium. We hope you enjoy your lunch.
